“New Discoveries in Prehistoric South Florida”

On **Monday, December 8**, Robert Carr, co-founder of the Archaeological and Historical Conservancy, will be the guest speaker at the Friends’ Annual Meeting and Luncheon. Mr. Carr has worked as an archaeologist with the State of Florida’s Division of Historic Resources and with the National Park Service. He was Miami-Dade County’s first archaeologist and became the County’s Historic Preservation Director in 1999. He has a Master’s Degree in Anthropology from Florida State University and is a former editor of the Florida Anthropologist and former president of the Florida Archaeological Council.
