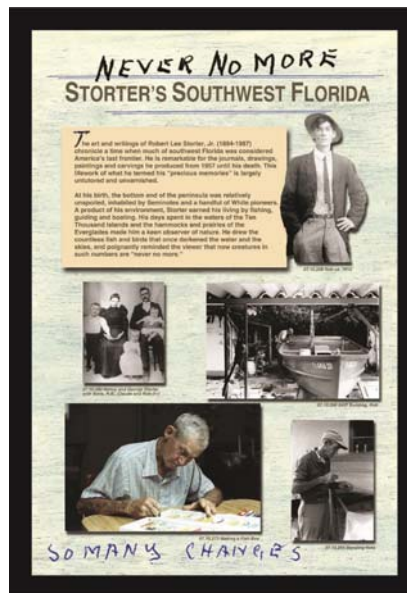

## **Rob Storter Collection**

Wonderful News!! The Rob Storter Traveling Exhibit is now a reality. The Mennello Museum in Orlando will be the first venue to showcase this new exhibition based on the memoirs of Rob Storter (1894-1987), which were published in 2000 as the book “Crackers in the Glade.” Rob Storter came from a family of early settlers in the small village of Everglade. He was a self-taught artist and sketched pictures of his rural lifestyle and environment and annotated them

with stories, often bemoaning the wilderness that was being lost to development. The collection will be on exhibit from **Friday, May 17, through Sunday, January 5, 2014.** If you’re in the Orlando area during this time period, be sure to stop by. The Mennello Museum of American Art is located at 900 East Princeton Street (between I-4 and US17-92) and is open Tuesday – Saturday from 10:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Sunday noon to 4:30 p.m. The Museum is closed on Monday and major holidays.
