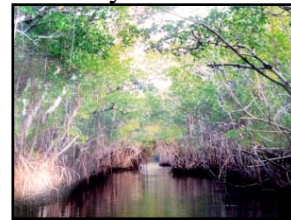
“Through the Eyes of Locals”

Museum Expands Parking Lot


At its October 28 meeting, the Board of County Commissioners voted unanimously to “appropriate \$36,000 from Museum Reserves to purchase and improve Vacant Lot #8374156004 in Everglades City, accept donation of \$30,000 from the Friends of the Museum of the Everglades towards acquisition of the property...” The vacant lot refers to the parking area located between the Museum and Susie’s Station Restaurant. This joint project between Collier County and FME allows for the Museum to increase the number of parking spaces from 9 to 37 which will greatly improve the accessibility of our visitors. The Friends wish to thank Mayor Hamilton and Commissioner Tim Nance for their assistance and the BCC for appropriating the funds necessary to acquire and improve the lot for our Museum of the Everglades.
