### *Connie Bransilver to Exhibit in the Pauline Reeves Gallery*

*‘Tenuous Hold: Our Fragile Wetland Habitat ’* is the title of the exhibit for October at the Museum of the Everglades. Many people are already familiar with Connie s’ photography from her illustrative book with Larry W. Richardson: *‘Florida & Unsung Wilderness; The Swamps. ’* Connie is a dedicated conservationist, past President of the North American Nature Photography Association, and a charter Fellow in the prestigious International League of Conservation Photographers. Her work spans over seven continents and her National Geographic Wild Chronicles segment on Madagascar premiered at the Telluride Film Festival. In addition to the above mentioned book, she has also authored *‘Wild Love Affair: Essence of Florida & Native Orchids ’* featuring her photograph of the Ghost Orchid that was selected as a main image at the IUCN Congress in Barcelona, Spain.
