She described how the Storter name is well known as one of the early pioneering families of southwest Florida. Rob Storter's memories of his life and times in the old Everglades are depicted in this one-of-a-kind collection of art and drawings. 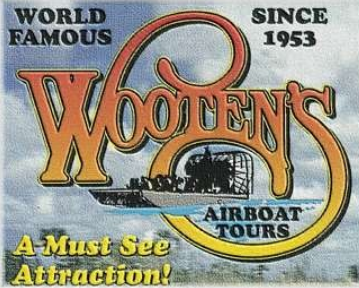
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
