These films will be shown at the Museum of the Everglades beginning on **Wednesday**, **July 16**, at 1:00 p.m. and will continue through August. The following is a schedule of the upcoming matinee movies this summer:

July 16: Distant Drums (1951) 1 hr. 41 minutes

Nonstop action adventure with Gary Cooper storming the Florida Everglades to put down the Seminole Indian Rebellion of 1840.

August 6: The President's Lady (1953) 1 hr. 36 minutes

President Andrew Jackson's, Charlton Heston, marriage to Rachel Donelson Robards, Susan Hayward, was considered a scandal. Was their marriage legal? Connection to Florida: Andrew Jackson served as the first military governor of Florida from March 1821 to November 1821.

August 13: The Palm Beach Story (1942) 1 hr. 28 minutes

Money makes the world go 'round or so Claudette Colbert believes when she divorces her struggling husband and supports him by marrying a millionaire. Connection to Florida: Filmed in Palm Beach.

August 20: Reap the Wild Wind (1955) 2 hrs.

Revolves around a ship wreck and murder on the high seas.

Connection to Florida: Filmed in the Florida Keys

August 27: Dimples (1936) 1 hr. 15 minutes

Connection to Florida: Step N. Fetchit was born and raised in Key West
